**SUBJECT:** **Approval of Updated Sewer System Management Plan**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that your Board approve the updated Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP) for the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District (Regional San) to comply with the Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the Regional San's Interceptor System.

**BACKGROUND:**

On May 2, 2006, the California State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) adopted the Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs), Order No. 2006-0003, for all publicly-owned sanitary sewer collection systems. Regional San's Interceptor System is subject to the requirements of the Statewide WDRs. The WDRs require that all publicly owned collection systems greater than one mile in length take all feasible steps to prevent Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSOs), develop an SSMP, and comply with WDR reporting requirements. The WDRs require that the agency's governing board approve the completed SSMP at a public meeting.

The WDRs also require that the SSMP must be updated every five years to include any significant program changes and the updated SSMP must be re-approved by the governing board upon completion of the update. The SSMP was initially approved by the Board on April 8, 2009.

**DISCUSSION:**

Notable changes made to the SSMP include minor modifications to Regional San's SSO Response Plan in response to the SWRCB's 2013 updates to the Monitoring and Reporting Program of the WDRs. Minor modifications were also made to reflect completion of Operating Agreements with various satellite agencies. Board approval of the updated SSMP will satisfy a step in Regional San's compliance with the WDRs. Regional San will then complete certification process in the SWRCB's electronic database prior to the WDRs' required five-year update deadline of April 22, 2014. These actions will complete Regional San's five-year SSMP update submission to maintain compliance with the WDRs.

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
**FINANCIAL ANALYSIS:**
