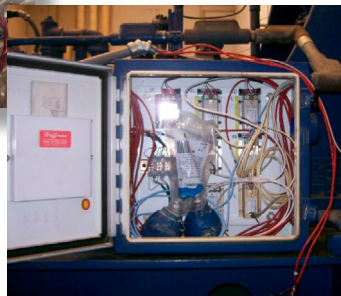
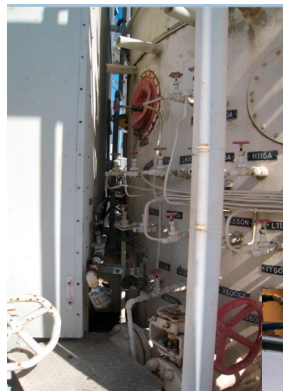
Control System Technicians maintain and repair pneumatic, chemical, electric, and electronic components, analyze equipment including computers, networks, and PLCs. Most equipment in industrial setting. Typical duties include:

- Troubleshoot, program, calibrate, repair, modify, install & documentation of equipment.
- Work with industrial process measurement equipment, gas detectors, protective monitoring and computerized control systems.
- Respond to emergency maintenance needs.

Regional San owns and operates the regional wastewater conveyance system and the 1,000 acre Sacramento Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant (SRWTP), near Elk Grove, California. The conveyance system consists of a network of 169 miles of interceptor pipelines and 11 large pump stations that convey wastewater to the SRWTP. The SRWTP is one of the largest wastewater treatment plants on the west coast.

Regional San is undertaking a \$1.5 billion effort - called the EchoWater Project - to take our region's wastewater treatment to a whole new level. When completed, the EchoWater Project will be capable of meeting our region's needs and protecting our region's waterways for generations to come.
