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**ADDENDUM NO. 1 TO RFP NO. 8376**

**THE CHANGES ARE AMENDED IN RFP NO. 8376 AS FOLLOWS:**

1. On Page 12 of the RFP document, under Section 7 entitled “Permits”, the provision has been revised to the following:

**PERMITS:**

- a. The Contractor represents and warrants to the Districts that Contractor has all licenses, permits, qualifications and approvals of whatsoever nature which are legally required for Contractor to operate a **waste disposal** business, Contractor represents and warrants to the Districts that Contractor shall, at his sole cost and expense, keep in effect at all times during the term of this Agreement any licenses, permits, and approvals which are legally required for Contractor to operate a waste disposal business.
- b. County of Sacramento Business License is required of any person who transacts or conducts any business, trade, profession, calling or occupation in the County of Sacramento.
- c. The Contractor shall submit a copy of its current, County of Sacramento business license, receipts or other evidence showing payment.

2. On Page 13 of the RFP document, under Section 15 entitled “Termination Upon Unsatisfactory Performance” the provision has been revised to the following”:

**TERMINATION UPON UNSATISFACTORY PERFORMANCE:**

Whenever, in the opinion of Districts, said service is not satisfactory, Contractor shall be advised of the reasons in writing. If Contractor fails to correct the unsatisfactory service within a reasonable time (in no event later than 7 days), Districts may declare the contract in default, terminate the contract, and contract with another **service** provider. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, the Districts shall have no obligation to give Contractor more than two (2) notices of unsatisfactory performance during the contract period. Should Contractor again fail to perform services pursuant to the contract, The Districts may declare the contract in default, terminate the contract, and contract with another. Contractor may be held liable and may be assessed any and all costs for the re-procurement of contracted services.

**3.** On Page 34 of the RFP document, Worksheet 3 – Vendor Price Proposal has been revised and attached hereto as Attachment 1. Discard Page 34 of Original RFP document.

- A. Rates requested are per week. Please refer to the revised Worksheet 3 – Vendor Price Proposal, which replaces Page 34 of the RFP.
- B. 10 yd to 40 yd FL Waste Bin Types have been revised to **RO** Waste Bin Types. Proposers must utilize the Revised Worksheet 3 – Vendor Price Proposal attached hereto (Attachment 1), and discard the original page no. 34 within the RFP document.
- C. Please list the disposal rates separately. Please refer to the revised Worksheet 3 – Vendor Price Proposal, which replaces Page 34 of the RFP.
- D. If cost is based upon service minutes of relocation from SRWTP to the destination location, or some other cost basis, please provide the detailed cost calculation. Please refer to the revised Worksheet 3 – Vendor Price Proposal, which replaces Page 34 of the RFP.

**4. Waste Disposal Location:**

All waste must be disposed of at the Kiefer Landfill located at 12701 Kiefer Boulevard and Grant Line Road, Sloughouse, CA 95683. The Districts will furnish a copy of the “Certificate of Acceptance”, the waste clearance granted by the County of Sacramento Department of Waste Management & Recycling to the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District (Regional San) - to the successful Contractor who is awarded a contract for the Waste Removal Services.

**5. Sealed Doors for Concrete Recycle:**

Waste containers provided for concrete recycle must have sealed doors.
