LINED DEDICATED LAND DISPOSAL UNIT 5 (LDLD 5)

Below are bid irregularities that Regional San has experienced in previous recent construction bids. **This list is strictly for informational purposes only. Bidders should not expect that this list covers all potential bid irregularities.**

- Failure to submit the Bid Form (Section 00 41 00).
- Error(s) in math on Bid Form. Verify and ensure all bid line items add up correctly, to the Total Bid Amount.
- Failure to acknowledge all issued addenda on the Bid Form (Section 00 41 00).
- Failure to include all the required forms as a part of the bid. A list of the forms that are required to be submitted with the Bid is included in the Bid Form (Section 00 41 00).
- Failure to submit the required supplementary information within three (3) business days after the opening of bids, no later than 4:00 pm on the third business day. Refer to the Bid Form (Section 00 41 00) for the documents that are required from the three (3) apparent low bidders.
- Failure to properly identify and list subcontractors on the Proposed Subcontractors Form (Section 00 43 36). The Contractor shall list only one subcontractor for each portion of the work, as defined by the Contractor in the bid. Only first tier contractors under direct contract to the Contractor, performing work on the project site, in an amount in excess of one-half of one percent (0.5%) of the Contractor's total bid are required to be listed. Understand the definition of a subcontractor, which is defined in Instructions to Bidders (00 21 13 paragraph 1.04.C.2), and on the Proposed Subcontractors Form (Section 00 43 36).

If a Contractor fails to specify a subcontractor for any portion of the work to be performed under this contract in excess of one-half of one percent (0.5%) of the total bid, the Contractor shall self-perform that portion of the Work.

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- Error(s) in the listing of the California contractor license number(s), including typos, number transpositions, etc., must be corrected by the Contractor within 24 hours after the bid opening. Contractor shall verify that the contractor's license numbers are correct and accurately correspond to the submitted name and location for every contractor listed in the bid documents.
- Failure to initial strikeouts or other changes to the bid documents.
- Failure to calculate the correct percentage of work that the subcontractor will perform on the project.
- Failure to meet the minimum required percentage of work specified to be performed by the Contractor's own forces.
- Failure to provide the correct value for the bid bond.

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
