



## NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS CONTRACT 4283

### TERTIARY TREATMENT FACILITIES (TTF)

Regional San is advertising for bids for the construction of the Tertiary Treatment Facilities (TTF) Project at the Sacramento Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant (SRWTP). The project consists of construction of facilities to treat secondary effluent (SE) from a new biological nutrient removal (BNR) process. The project encompasses three major unit processes, including a Filter Influent Pumping Station (FIPS), Granular Media Filtration (GMF), and Disinfection Contact Basins (DCB). The FIPS will convey SE from the existing SE channel to the GMF inlet structure, and will include tie-ins to the SE channel, drum screens, pump wet wells, discharge headers, and flow metering. GMF includes the Seasonal Flow Diversion Structure (SFDS), chemical mixing, granular media filters, filter backwash system, and waste filter backwash (WFBW) equalization basins and backwash return pumps. GMF consists of dual media filters, using anthracite and sand media. The DCB components consist of disinfectant mixing, influent and effluent channels, disinfection contact basins, and dechlorination. Other elements of the project include an Area Control Center (ACC) and Substation 75 building, Substation 79 Building, transformer yards 75 and 79, WFBW Pumping Station, Reclaimed Water Pumping Stations, DCB Tank Drain Pumping Station, chemical storage and feed systems, stormwater handling and detention, civil and electrical site work, and Effluent Observation Structure (EOS).

There will be a **mandatory** pre-bid conference and walk-through for prime contractors at 09:00 am, January 24, 2018 (unless changed by addendum) at the SRWTP Administrative Building, Commons Room at 8521 Laguna Station Road, Elk Grove, CA, 95758. Subcontractors are not required to attend. Attendees should be prepared to walk approximately one mile during the tour. A general engineering contractor, class A license is required.

Prequalification is required for general contractors, as well as prequalification for electrical subcontractors; instrumentation and control subcontractors; and filter influent pump suppliers.

There is no cost to access and download contract documents, however registration is required.

This Project is being substantially funded by a loan from a Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) program. Project requires posting CWSRF Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) solicitations for bids or proposals for a minimum of 30 calendar days before the bid opening date.

This project is subject to the Davis-Bacon Act, Buy American Requirement for iron and steel products used in the project, and federal Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) regulations (reference 40 Code of Federal Regulations Part 33 – Participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises in U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Programs).

All labor on the project shall be paid no less than the minimum wage rates as established by the U.S. Secretary of Labor or as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. The higher of the two rates will be paid in accordance with the following acts and codes: 1) The Davis Bacon Act, and 2) Section 1770, and following, of the California Labor Code.

A Contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, or be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter, unless currently registered with the Department of Industrial Relations and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5. It is not a violation of this section for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.

The County of Sacramento received final approval as a Labor Compliance Program effective March 15, 1994.
