PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposed Project improvements include but are not limited to the following major elements:

- The existing ESB-D RPP membrane liner will be removed and replaced with a new concrete liner system consisting

of 7-inch thick Jointed-Plain Concrete Pavement (JPCP) on the floors of the basins and 6-inch thick reinforced shotcrete on the berms.

- Repairs to the existing concrete apron in ESB-D will be performed, consisting primarily of vegetation removal, crack repairs, spalled concrete repairs, and resealing of expansion joints.
- Removal of existing asphalt concrete paving and repaving portions of the ESB-D perimeter patrol road with 7-inch thick JPCP and lime-treated base.
- Installation of washdown hydrant connections and piping within ESB-D and modifications to existing washdown system (EWS) piping in ESB-C3.
- Installation of an ESB-D underdrain system beneath the new JPCP liner. The system will tie into the existing ESB-C3 underdrain system which discharges to the existing Underdrain Pumping Station.
- Installation and removal of a temporary cofferdam to provide temporary bypass between ESB-C3 and the ESB-D Pumping Station while ESB-D is out of service during construction.
- Modifications to the 102-inch final effluent (FE) piping at the ESB-D Junction Vault.
- Removal of a temporary concrete slab section in the northeast corner of ESB-A to be replaced with an 8-inch thick reinforced concrete slab.
- Repair of portions of the existing ESB-A concrete liner including concrete crack repair, replacement of sections of liner, and resealing of expansion joints.

Award of this Contract requires a valid California contractor's license with the classification identified above.

Each bid must be submitted on the bid forms provided in the Contract Documents. Each bid must also be accompanied by security in the form of a bid bond issued by a corporate surety, a certified check or cashier's check payable to the Treasurer of Sacramento County, for an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the aggregate sum of the bid.

The successful bidder shall be required to execute a Material and Labor Payment Bond and Performance Bond, issued by a corporate surety, acceptable to the County of Sacramento, each for not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.

Pursuant to Section 22300 et seq. of the Public Contract Code, Contractor may, at its own expense, substitute securities for any money being withheld by the District to ensure performance under this contract.

The statements of experience shall be submitted by the 3 apparent low bidders to the Internal Services Division-Contract Services, 10060 Goethe Road, Sacramento, CA 95827 within 3 business days following the opening of bids. The required experience statements are as follows:

1. The General Contractor, construction experience of similar magnitude and character to that contemplated under this contract.

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2. Those subcontractors listed in the Designation of Subcontractors, construction experience of similar magnitude and character to that contemplated under this contract.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.

LABOR COMPLIANCE PROGRAM: The County of Sacramento received final approval from the Director of California Department of Industrial Relations as a Labor Compliance Program effective March 15, 1994. All questions regarding this Labor Compliance Program and prevailing wage requirements should be directed to the Labor Compliance Section at (916) 875-2711. In accordance with Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code, the payment of the general prevailing rate of per diem wages or the general prevailing rate of per diem wages for holiday and overtime is not required for any public works project of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) or less when the project is for construction work, or for any public works project of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) or less when the project is for alteration, demolition, repair, or maintenance work.

This is a construction project in accordance with Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code.

Pursuant to California Labor Code Section 1720 and following, and Section 1770 and following, the successful bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Copies of the prevailing wage determinations are on file at the office of the County of Sacramento Labor Compliance Program, 9700 Goethe Road, Suite D, Sacramento, CA 95827, and are also available on the internet at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD>.

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality in any bid, and to determine which bid, in the judgment of the Board, is the lowest responsive bid of a responsible bidder.
