



ADDENDUM NO. 1

RFP#8397 Sodium Hypochlorite

The following changes are amended in RFP#8397 Sodium Hypochlorite

1. On page 6 under the “Information provided in this proposal” section, reference to the **Contractor License Certification** has been deleted.
2. On page 7 under the “Proposal Response” section, reference to the **Contractor License Certification** has been deleted.
3. Page 34 of this document, “Contractor License Certification” has been deleted from this RFP. Please remove it from your proposal package.
4. Page 14 under “Contract Negotiations”, the existing text is modified as thus: ***“Upon mutual agreement with Contractor, Regional San reserves the right to add terms and conditions during contract negotiations. These terms and conditions will be within the scope of the Request for Proposal.”***
5. Page 18 under Spillage, the following sentence is to be added following the second sentence in the document. This sections is modifies as thus: “...The Supplier must provide safety training on the safe handling and use of the chemical and emergency procedures in the event of a leak or spill. ***Supplier shall ensure their drivers be trained on spill clean-up on at least an annual basis.*** Should a chemical spill or leak result due to negligence, faulty equipment, or inferior packaging on the part of the Supplier or their agents, the Supplier and their agents must be responsible for cleaning the spill or leakage and for bearing and cost incurred due to spill or leakage clean-up.”
6. Page 20, reference to specific delivered product temperature has been removed. The text following the product General characteristics is modified as thus: ~~“Sodium hypochlorite should be stored in a dark area where the temperature does not exceed 80 deg F (i.e. 30 deg C) prior to delivery. Preferably sodium hypochlorite should be stored at temperatures below 68 deg F (i.e. 20 deg C) prior to delivery.~~ The Sodium Hypochlorite shall be filtered by manufacturer to remove

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precipitates and particulates and to reduce thermal degradation effects. ***Supplier is to practice best efforts to minimize product temperature prior to delivery.***

7. Page 26, subsection 8 – revise five year history of accident or violations of Federal, State and local laws incurred by the Proposer to begin on January 1, 2017
8. Page 27, subsection 3 “Supplier Performance Record” – The text is revised as thus: “...Supplier should clearly show their safety record, record of chemical spills they or their delivery company have been responsible for, and the percentage of orders delivered within the time required in various contracts ***within the state of California.***”
9. Page 9, item 12 “Title” – revise text to read as thus: “Except as otherwise expressly provided herein, title to and risk of loss on all items shipped by seller to buyer shall pass to the buyer upon buyer’s inspection and acceptance of such items at buyer’s building ***after product passes the hose connection flange on bulk storage tanks.***”
