Questions and Answers

1. Will the contractor be responsible for the **Hydrologic and Hydraulics System Performance Analysis** and **Geotechnical Analysis**? (Typically required for a Section 408 permit.)

If the proposer believes that a Hydrologic and Hydraulics System Performance Analysis and Geotechnical Analysis is necessary to determine a preferred abandonment approach or to acquire the necessary permits to facilitate project implementation, this analysis should be included in the proposed approach to Task 2 or Task 3 of RFP No. 9067. In this case, the proposer is welcome to advise if they have the in-house expertise to perform such work, if they would plan to sub-contract the work, or explore the use of a Regional San on-call geotechnical contract to perform the work.
